

## **Temple Sinai - NFTY Scholarship Program**

The Temple Sinai Youth Scholarship Program has funds available for NFTY program participants to attend NFTY Kallot (conventions). Participant families may receive scholarship funds by demonstrating a financial need. Each participant/family must fill out the TEMPLE SINAI-NFTY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION.

### **Responsibility**

The Youth Director will set up a sub-committee that will adhere to the guidelines for the annual administration of the funds. This committee will determine the total amount of scholarship funds available each year, based on history and funds available.

The Youth Director is responsible to ensure the safekeeping and confidentiality of all records and to maintain the historical accuracy.

Identities of families seeking scholarship will remain private with only the knowledge of the Youth Director. Applications will be presented to the scholarship committee via a spreadsheet with a participant number and the key information.

### **Distribution**

All scholarship money is distributed based on the number of applicants and scholarship funds available. Funds will be paid directly to the NFTY office to offset Kallah registration fees. An individual may receive one youth fund scholarship per NFTY event.

### **Requirements**

Participant must be a NFTY, SAFETY, and Temple Sinai member in good standing. All membership dues must be paid in full at the time of the request.

Participant must agree to a requisite number of Temple Sinai/SAFETY volunteer assignments, demonstrating a mutual commitment between the Temple and the individual. Minimum requirement is one SAFETY or Temple event.

If an individual receives a scholarship and does not attend the event, the family is responsible for reimbursing the scholarship fund. If payment is not made, that individual will not be eligible for future scholarships.

**All applications are due a minimum of 60 days prior to the start date of event. Late applications will not be considered.**
