## How our students spend their time

Grades	Activities
<b>K-2</b>	A fun Sunday morning for young children that introduces them to the major holidays and core values of Jewish life and exposes them to Hebrew letters and words. Their morning includes snack and playground time. Four Family Fun Days each year add to their experience.
<b>3-6</b>	Sunday mornings are filled with Tefillah (prayer), Hebrew, Judaica, art and special projects. These grades each have at least one family program per year.  During Hebrew School, students use the Mitkadem Hebrew program. This individualized prayer-based program, guided by outstanding teachers, is supplemented by Mitkadem Digital and prepares students for Bar/Bat Mitzvah and Jewish life.
<b>7-10</b>	Prior to Bar/Bat Mitzvah, 7 <sup>th</sup> graders continue Hebrew on Sunday mornings.  Starting at 10:15, our older students are engaged in discussion and experiential learning with veteran teachers and clergy.
